Directions

From Garden State Parkway, North or South:

Take Garden State Parkway North/South to Exit 138 (marked Kenilworth-Elizabeth southbound and Kenilworth-Roselle Park northbound). Turn left at the end of the exit ramp onto Galloping Hill Road, which becomes the Boulevard. Proceed straight on Boulevard. Turn right onto Michigan Ave. at traffic light. Turn left onto Monroe Ave. and proceed to David Brearley Middle/High School on the left. **(Parking available in the school lot.) To walk to 5K/2K starting point**, exit school parking lot (rear gate), go left and proceed on Washington Ave. to North 21st Street. Turn right and proceed to run/walk starting point (N. 22nd/N.21st Street parking lot behind Seniors' Center) on the left.

From I-78 East/West: Take I-78 East/West to Exit 52 (Garden State Parkway South). Follow directions from Garden State Parkway North/South.

From NJ Turnpike (I-95) North/South: Take NJ Turnpike (I-95) North/South to Exit 14 (marked Newark Airport). After the toll booth at Exit 14, take I-78 West. Take I-78 West to Exit 52 (Garden State Parkway South). Follow directions from Garden State Parkway North/South.
