The Scott Coffee Moorestown Rotary 8K is named for the founder of the race who passed away in the summer of 2006. Proceeds benefit the activities of Moorestown Rotary Charities and the Scott Coffee Education Endowment for scholarships. The race is presented by the Moorestown Rotary Club in cooperation with the Township of Moorestown, and the Moorestown Community House.

Scott Coffee Endowment



Scott Coffee founded and chaired the Moorestown Rotary Run since 1984. What was originally a small fundraiser with participation of around 125 runners has become a major fundraiser for the Rotary with a class field of over 850 runners. When Scott suddenly passed away only a month after the 2006 race, it not only left a huge void in our lives, but an active, dedicated and generous volunteer to our community was tragically silenced. In his honor, Moorestown Rotary has changed the name of the race and founded the Scott Coffee Education Endowment (make checks payable to Moorestown Rotary Charities) which will provide scholarships for deserving high school students.

The Course

8K – flat and fast – starting and finishing at the Community House on Main Street. The traffic-free USATF certified course passes through the historic, tree-lined streets of 300 year old Moorestown. There are splits every mile and two water stops.

Rt. 38: East ½ mile from Moorestown Mall, Left on Church St., Right on Main St.

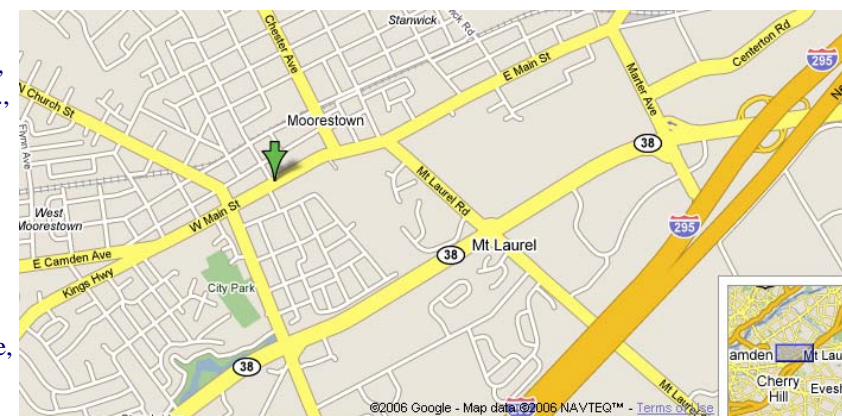
Rt. 73: - to Rt. 38, and as above.
