

Some Facts About F.O.P.

- F.O.P. is one of the rarest and most disabling genetic conditions known to humankind. F.O.P. stands for Fibrodysplasia Ossificans Progressiva.
- F.O.P. is a rare genetic disorder in which muscles, tendons, ligaments, and other connective tissues turn to bone.
- Movement in areas affected by F.O.P. (commonly the neck, spine, chest, shoulders, elbows, wrists, hips, knees, ankles and jaw) over time becomes difficult or impossible.
- People with F.O.P. experience different rates of bone formation; for some it is very rapid while some can go months or years without a flare up of bone formation.
- Currently there is no treatment or cure for F.O.P., which makes it all the more important to fundraise to support efforts aimed at finding one.
- Research on F.O.P. will provide answers to research for more common conditions such as osteoporosis, osteoarthritis, post amputation treatment and specific complications of hip replacements, spinal cord injuries, head injuries & some heart valve disorders.
- The gene responsible for the disease was identified in 2006 at the F.O.P. Laboratory at the University of Pennsylvania School of Medicine. The F.O.P. lab is in the process of developing animal models in mice to test potential treatments for the not-so-distant future.
- The long-range effect of F.O.P. research on other conditions is critical. Most recently, soldiers that traumatically have lost limbs in the Iraqi War are experiencing extra bone growth similar to F.O.P. Unlocking the mystery of F.O.P. will most certainly help answer questions for more commonly known bone-related conditions.
- The Ian L. Cali F.O.P. Fund was established in 1995 at the University of PENN Medical Center in order to secure the advancement of F.O.P. research for F.O.P. patients worldwide.
